Annual Report April 2012 to March 2013

It is always tempting in an annual report to talk about what is happening now. With the recent handover of Grange Court and its opening to the public however, that is all for next years report. We decided it was sensible to be brief and to highlight some key achievements and milestones over the 12 months. It should not be forgotten that there was a constant effort throughout the year to get the successful completion of Grange Court. There was also ongoing discussions about the Millennium Green and the Neighbourhood Plan.

- April. We get the news that the Heritage Lottery Fund have agreed to our bid for £300,000
- May. We visit Norton Hall Development Trust with the Bridge Street Buddies to give them a look at a developed childrens centre run by the community
- ➡ June. We help the Bridge Street Buddies sort out the Cheaton Close proposed street party. We hold another Leominster Convention and the idea of a Time Currency is first discussed
- July. The LARC news is distributed to the whole town along with the annual report. LARC and Grange Court plays a central role in the Leominster Tent as part of the Queens Jubilee visit to Herefordshire. The Board hold a full planning away day.
- August. The process of appointing Heritage Interpretation consultants starts
- September. Imagemakers appointed for design and delivery of interpretation works in Grange Court. Post of Heritage Development worker advertised. Jubilee exhibition reprised in the Priory for a weekend. Time currency organising group visit Blaengarw in south Wales.
- October. Polly Robinson appointed as Heritage Development worker. WRW main contractors leave Grange Court, local company G P Thomas appointed through AMEY to complete works outstanding.
- November. LARC newsletter distributed to nearly every house in Leominster. Time Bank seminar held in Bridge Street Sports Centre facilitated by Time Banking Wales. Time Bank gets major thumbs up from voluntary and statutory groups attending.
- December. Polly starts as Heritage Development worker, but based in the town Council offices.
- ➡ January. The new Grange Court bell is purchased and installed courtesy of Phillip Baldwin and family. Much of the interpretation work is commissioned
- **February.** First HLF event held in Corn Square on Pancake Day handing out free pancakes and advertising for future volunteers and visitors.
- March. Auditions for Heritage News Channel held and filming starts. Leominster Convention held in Grange Court despite building still not handed over and 4 inches of snow.
